The CMAC was formed in January 2006 and consists of up to eleven property owners. Our mission statement is:

“To provide one voice that represents the collective interest of Cedar Mountain property owners to bring issues, needs, and solutions to the appropriate agencies.”

Since our formation, the following are some of the actions we've taken:

- Assisted the Kane County Hospital locate a site for a clinic. The clinic is located across Highway 14 from Duck Creek Village.
- Coordinated with the WKCSSD #1 to increase trash pickup to seven days a week. Continuing to assist in the identification of a potential site for year round dumpsters plus occasional placement of roll-offs to accommodate large item disposal.
- Met with Sheriff's Department to communicate security and safety needs on Cedar Mountain.
- Held public hearings with Garkane, South Central Communications, Roads Supervisor, and US Forest Service.
- Working with US Forest Service and Parks and Recreation to begin expansion and connectivity of ATV/snowmobile trails.
- Established a website and an email distribution list to enhance communication with property owners.
- Provided input for state legislation which will allow non-resident property owners to have a vote in some issues within our area.
- Continuing to formulate plans to establish a town site in the area to provide services to Cedar Mountain property owners. Discussions with County, State Representative, the Utah Association of Special Districts, and the Forestry Department have been and will continue to gain knowledge and direction to establish a site.

What can you do as a property owner? Attend CMAC meetings which are held the third Saturday of each month at 10:00 a.m. Check the agendas posted on the website prior to the meeting for meeting location.
