The CMAC was formed in January 2006 and consists of up to eleven property owners. Our mission statement is:

“To provide one voice that represents the collective interest of Cedar Mountain property owners to bring issues, needs, and solutions to the appropriate agencies.”

Since our formation, the following are some of the actions we've taken:

- Assisted the Kane County Hospital locate a site for a clinic. The clinic was closed recently due to financial issues; however, CMAC is actively pursuing its reopening.
- Coordinated with the WKCSSD #1 to increase trash pickup to seven days a week and winter trash pickup in multiple locations.
- Met with Sheriff's Department to communicate security and safety needs on Cedar Mountain.
- Held public hearings with Garkane, South Central Communications, Roads Supervisor, and US Forest Service.
- Working with US Forest Service and Parks and Recreation to continue to expand ATV/snowmobile trails and enhance communication with property owners and visitors.
- Established a website and an email distribution list to enhance communication with property owners.
- Provided input for state legislation which will allow non-resident property owners to have a vote in some issues within our area and additional legislation wherein registered voters elect the CMFPD Board members instead of appointments made by the County.
- Began a quest to obtain land from the US Forestry through a Town Site Act. The County is spearheading this activity, and CMAC certainly desires to assist in this endeavor.

What can you do as a property owner? Attend CMAC meetings which are held the third Saturday of each month at 10:00 a.m. (except the months of April, July, October, and December) at the Fire Station. Check out website for location and agendas.
