

Addendum 2 – CMAC 2007 Contact Plan

The following Contact Plan developed by the Cedar Mountain Advisory Council (CMAC) lays out the near term steps to achieve guidance and direction for establishing a governing entity for Cedar Mountain. This initial plan also includes communicating CMAC findings to our MOU partners and Cedar Mountain property owners. Note that this is a preliminary top level plan subject to change as the Council progresses through the steps identified below.
