The CMAC was formed in January 2006 and consists of eleven property owners. Our mission statement is:

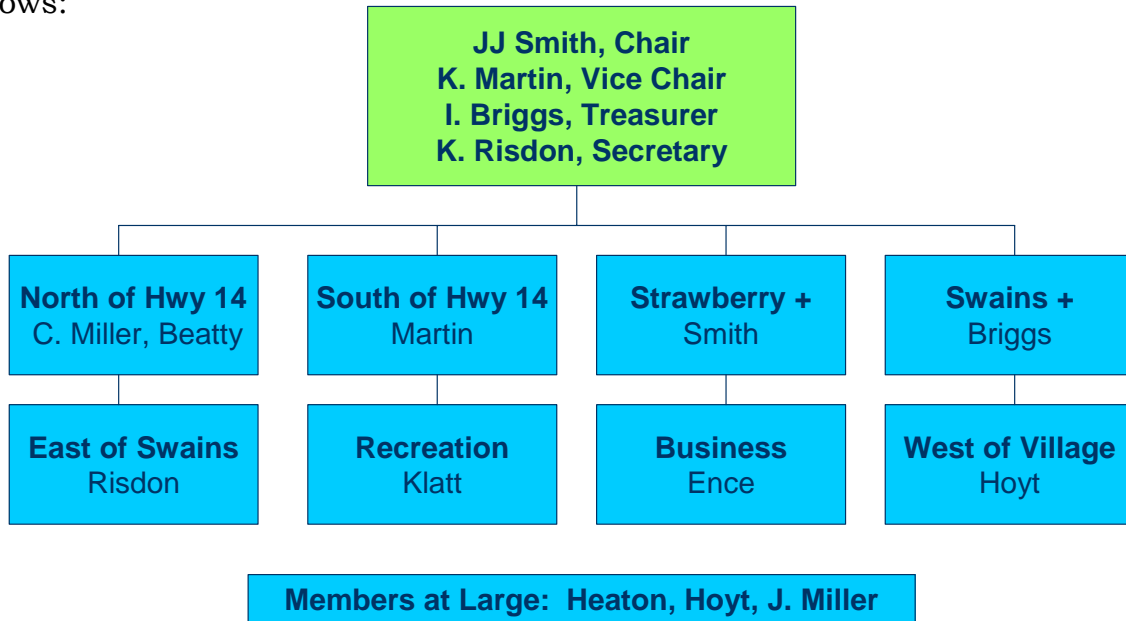
“To provide one voice that represents the collective interests of Cedar Mountain property owners to bring issues, needs, and solutions to the appropriate agencies.”
