The CMAC was formed in January 2006 and currently consists of twelve volunteer property owners. Our mission statement is:

“To provide one voice that represents the collective interest of Cedar Mountain property owners to bring issues, needs, and solutions to the appropriate agencies.”

Since our formation, the following are some of the actions we've taken:

- Assisted the Kane County Hospital locate a site for a clinic. The clinic is located across Highway 14 from Duck Creek Village.
- Coordinated with the WKCSSD #1 to increase trash pickup to seven days a week and a trial winter trash pick up during the 2008/2009 winter months.
- Met with Sheriff's Department to communicate security and safety needs on Cedar Mountain.
- Held public hearings with Garkane, South Central Communications, Roads Supervisor, and US Forest Department.
- Working with US Forest Department and Parks and Recreation to begin expansion and connectivity of ATV/snowmobile trails and to communicate safety.
- Established a website and an email distribution list to enhance communication with property owners.
- Provided input for state legislation which now allows non-resident property owners to be eligible to run for board memberships.
- Continuing to formulate plans to establish a town site in the area to provide services to Cedar Mountain property owners. Discussions with County, State Representative, the Utah Association of Special Districts, and the Forestry Department have been and will continue to gain knowledge and direction to establish a site.

What can you do as a property owner? Attend CMAC meetings which are held the third Saturday of each month (except July and December) at 10:00 a.m. Check the agendas posted on the website prior to the meeting for meeting location.
