# Today's Goal

- To present a concept for a governing structure for Cedar Mountain

# Background

- In an effort to gain understanding of Cedar Mountain's challenges, we had public hearings with the following: Roads Supervisor, US Forest Service, Sheriff's Dept, WKCSSD#1, Garkane, South Central Communications, Kane County Hospital
- To obtain guidance on potential governing entities, CMAC met with Mr. LeGrand Bitter (UASD) and Representative Mike Noel

# Concept: Service Agency

- Created by the County
- Hybrid between Special and Local districts
  - Special Service District: Dependent; created by the County
  - Local District: Independent; created by resolution and vote of citizens
  - Service Agency: More Independent; created by the County
- Can maintain more than two special service districts

# Concept: Service Agency, cont.



## Concept, cont.

- Service Agency board would consist of two members from each Special Service District plus three elected members
- Special Service District board members reporting to the Service Agency would be elected and have term limits
- The Service Agency would formally request funds from the County based on inputs from the Special Service Districts

# Townsite Act

- CMAC also recommends actively pursuing the Townsite Act simultaneously while establishing the Service Agency – both will take one to two years
- Envision establishing part time Government Services in the town which could include: County offices, sheriff's substation, utilities, medical facilities, and potentially a school
